The purpose of this letter is to update the residents on Cedar Point Road and the adjacent streets about the Cedar Point #14 Ejector Station Improvement Project. HPH Mechanical Contractors of Toledo, Ohio is under contract with the City of Sandusky to complete this sanitary improvement project. Starting the week of April 16th, Ohio Edison will be setting a new utility pole at the southeast corner of Cedar Point Road and Lane D. The existing utility pole next to the ejector station will be removed. This work is in preparation for the contractor to remove the existing pumps and a portion of the underground ejector station. Due to the depth of excavation and safety concerns the contractor will be installing concrete traffic barriers to keep traffic away from the construction area. This will limit traffic to one lane on Cedar Point Road and also limit traffic from Lane D to a right turn only when turning onto Cedar Point Road. The contractor will be maintaining the one lane of traffic with temporary traffic signals. This temporary traffic constraint is expected to last three weeks, weather dependent and not encountering any unforeseen construction conditions. We ask that you be patient with the construction activities.

This is so we can make sure your trash is still picked up on a weekly basis, since Lane D will not be accessible to the large trash hauler vehicles.
