### SNOW EMERGENCY ROUTES AND INCLEMENT WEATHER REMINDERS

*Sandusky* – Due to an increased amount of snowfall this season, residents and business owners are being reminded to pay attention to Snow Emergency Routes throughout the city. In the event of heavy snowfall, a parking ban may be placed on Snow Emergency Routes by the Department of Public Works. Any vehicle parked on these streets during that time may be ticketed or towed.

During snow storms, city Public Works crews focus on keeping the snow routes and major streets open through the duration of the storm. This allows essential and emergency travel around town even in the worst of conditions. Once the snow stops, the focus shifts to clearing the side streets and residential areas.

During winter storms, city, county and state snowplows work hard to make roads passable. All motorists should be mindful that plow drivers cannot see directly behind their trucks and often stop or back up. Staying a safe distance behind a snowplow will protect you from possible injury and protect your car from materials that plows spread on slick roadways.
