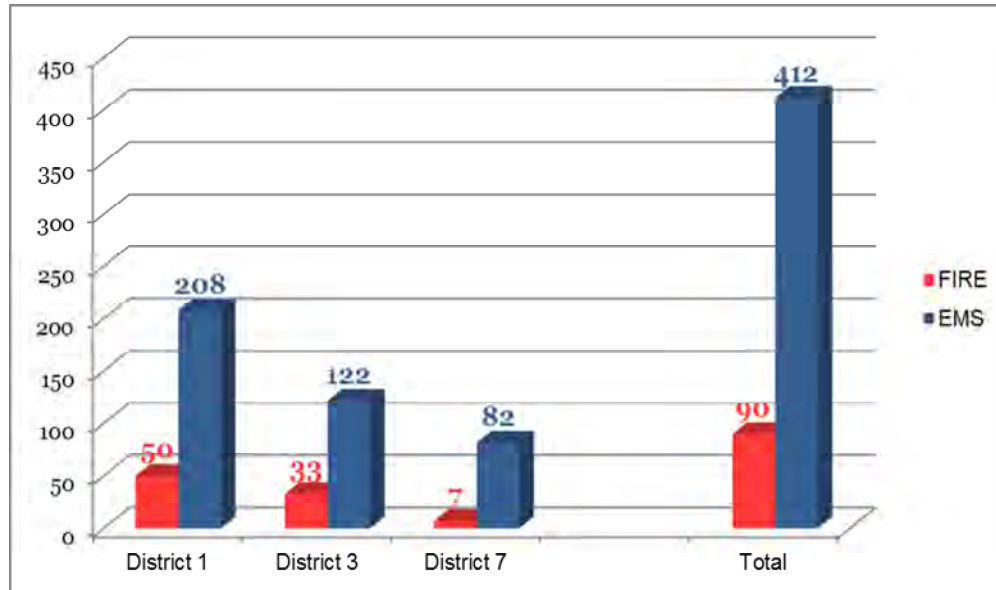

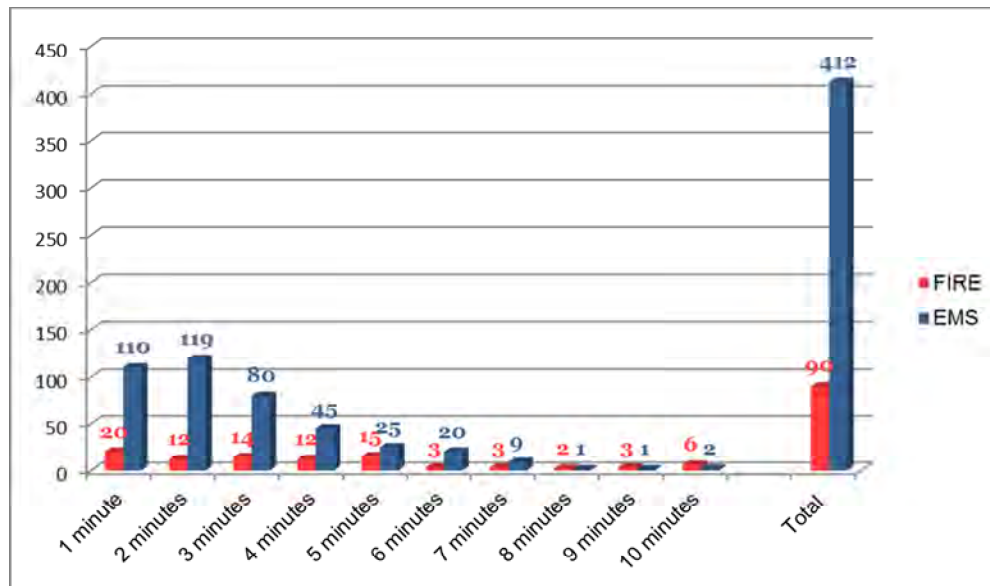


District Statistics



There were 502 incidents in May. 51% percent of all responses were in District 1. Responses in District 3 and District 7 were 31% and 18% respectively.

Response Time

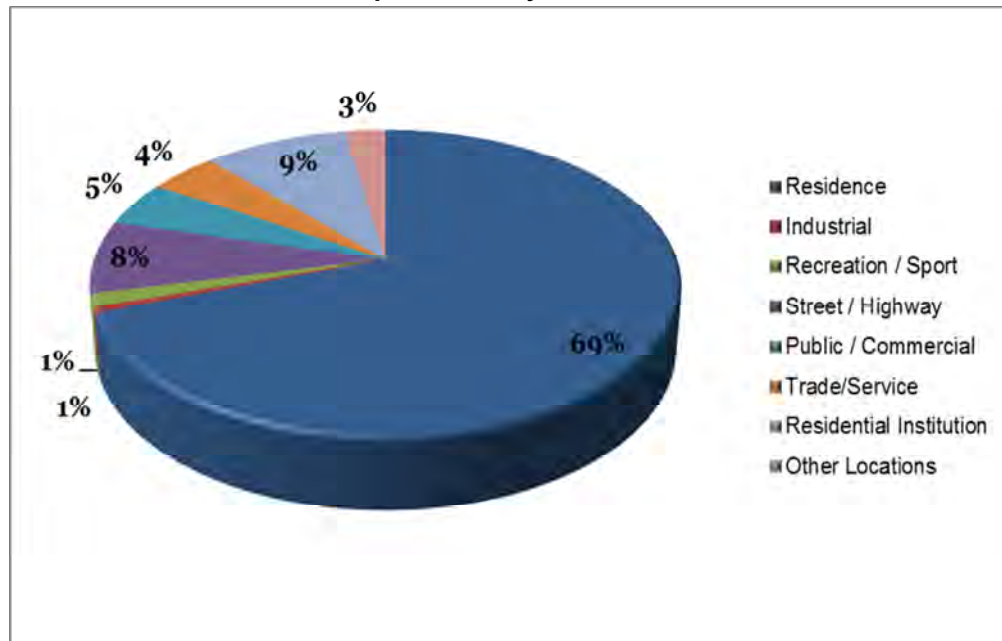


The average response time for fire emergencies was 4 minutes and 18 seconds. The average response time for EMS emergencies was 3 minutes and 08 seconds.

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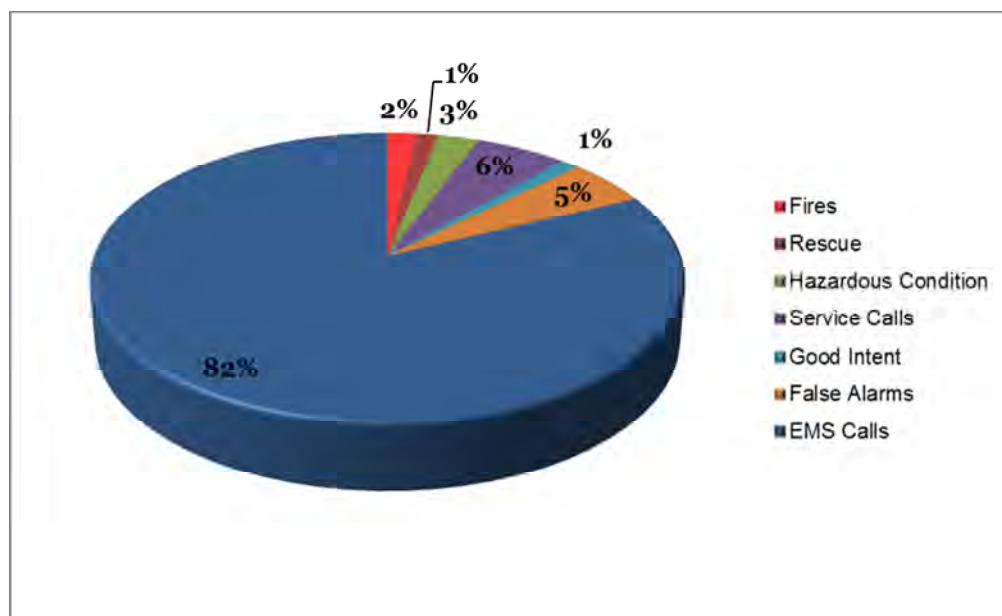


Response by Location



In May, 78% of all emergency responses were to residential occupancies (residences, nursing homes and residential institutions). Commercial buildings, recreational occupancies and streets and highways totaled 14%.

Incident Type

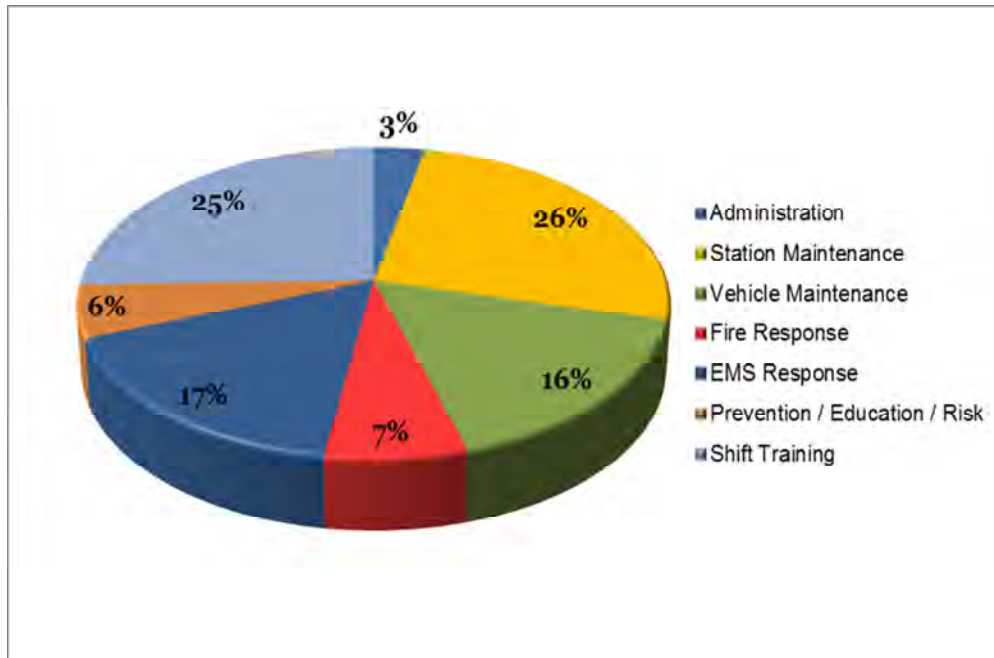


Ambulance service continues to be the highest requested service at 82%. Structure fire activity was 2% of all emergent activity. False alarms represented 5% of all May emergent activity. There was \$36,800 in fire loss.

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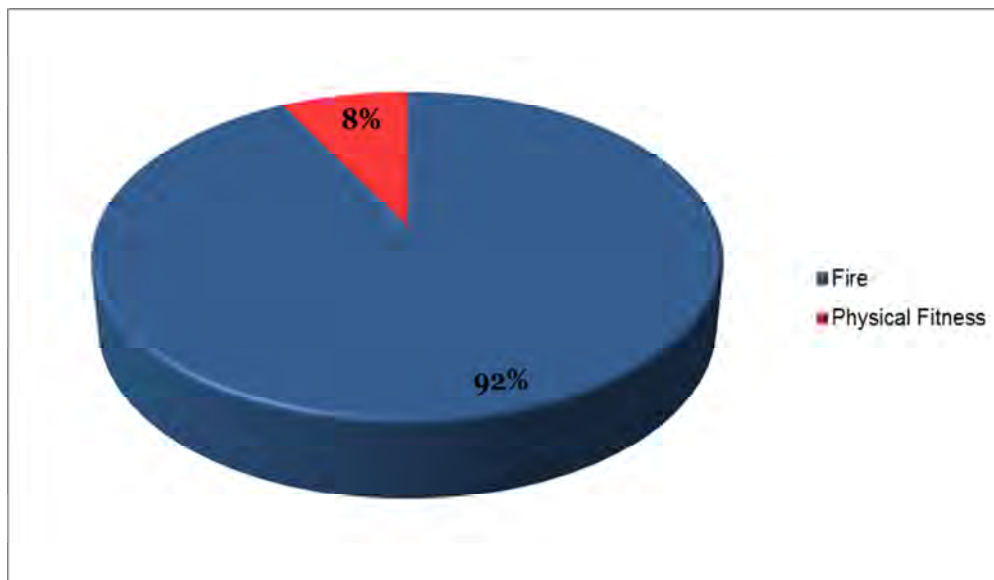


Activity



24% of all May activity was emergency response. Station and vehicle maintenance was 42% and training was 25%.

Training Analysis

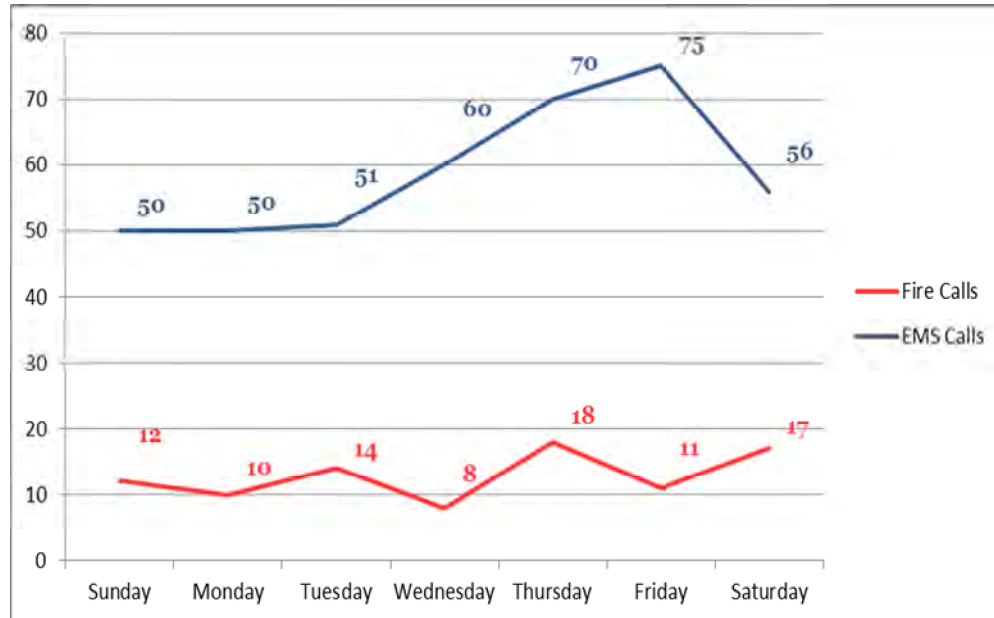


8% of May training was physical fitness training. 92% was fire training with the focus on Rapid Intervention Team (RIT) Operations.

Fuel Usage

- The Sandusky Fire Department used 947 gallons of fuel at a cost of \$3,353.30 in May 2014.

Staffing

- The average daily staffing for May was 11.6 personnel per day.
- Fire Station No. 7 was closed 15 times during the month of May.

Mutual –Aid

- Sandusky Fire Department received Mutual-Aid two times and provided Mutual-Aid four times in the month of May.
