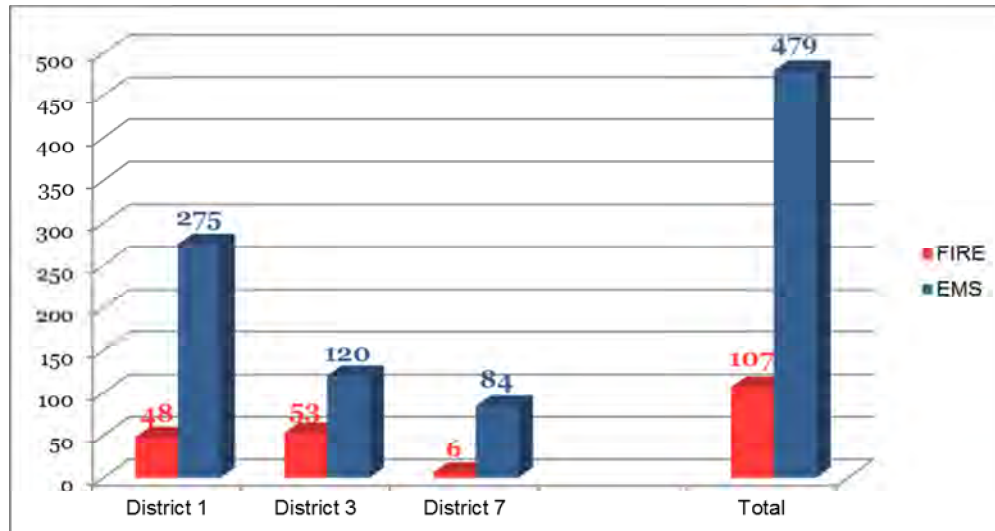

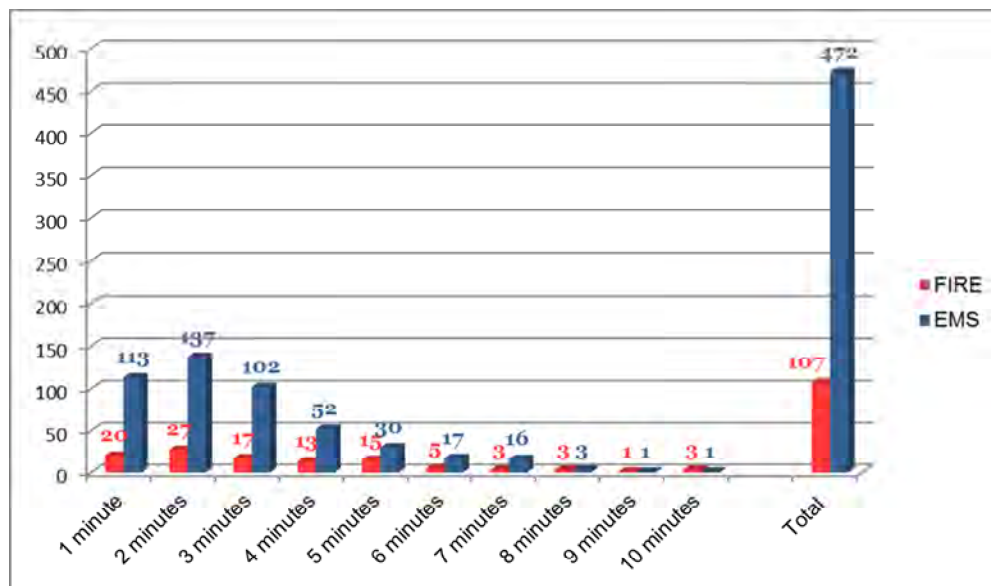


District Statistics



There were 586 responses in June. 55% of all responses were in District 1. Responses in District 3 were 30% and responses in District 7 were 15% respectively.

Response Time



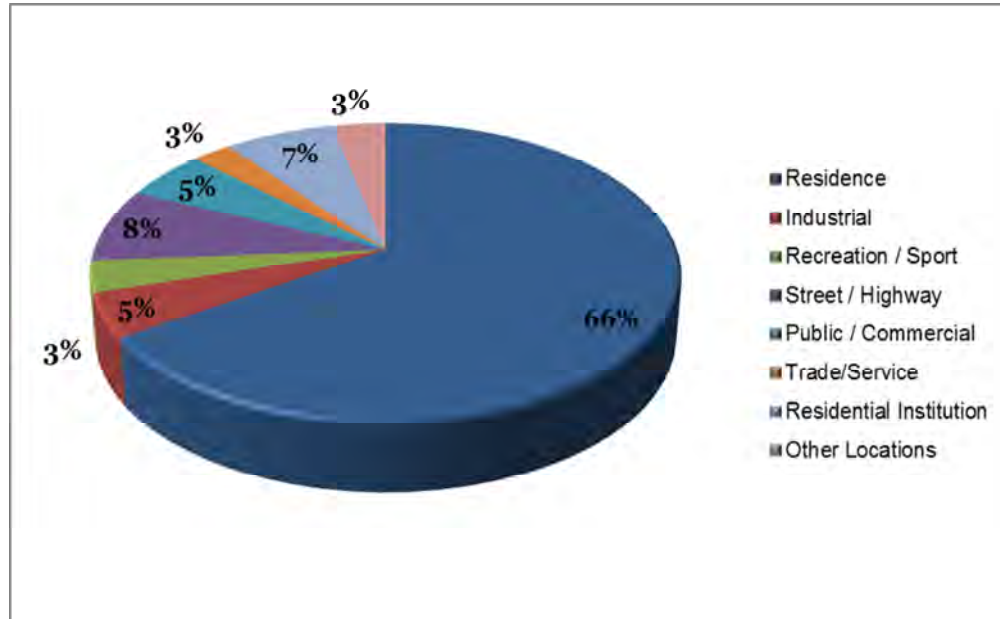
The average response time for fire emergencies was 3 minutes and 41 seconds. The average response time for EMS emergencies was 3 minutes and 10 seconds.

The Sandusky Fire Department responded to 70% of fire emergencies within four minutes and 81% of EMS emergencies within four minutes. This calculates to 77% of all emergency calls within four minutes.

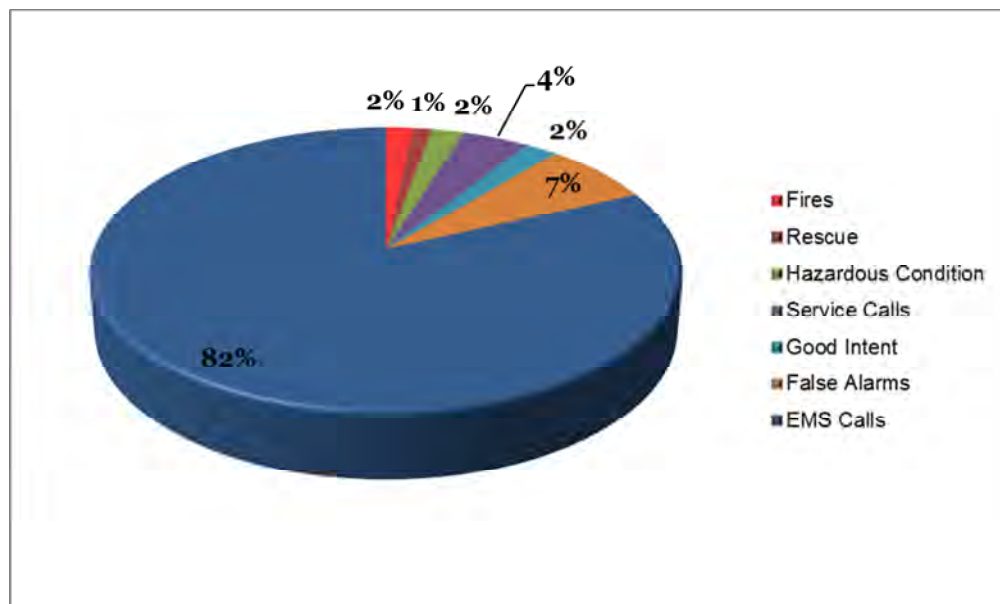


Response by Location



In June, sixty-five percent of all emergency responses were to residential occupancies (residences, nursing homes, and residential institutions). Commercial buildings, recreational occupancies and streets and highways totaled 16%.

Incident Type

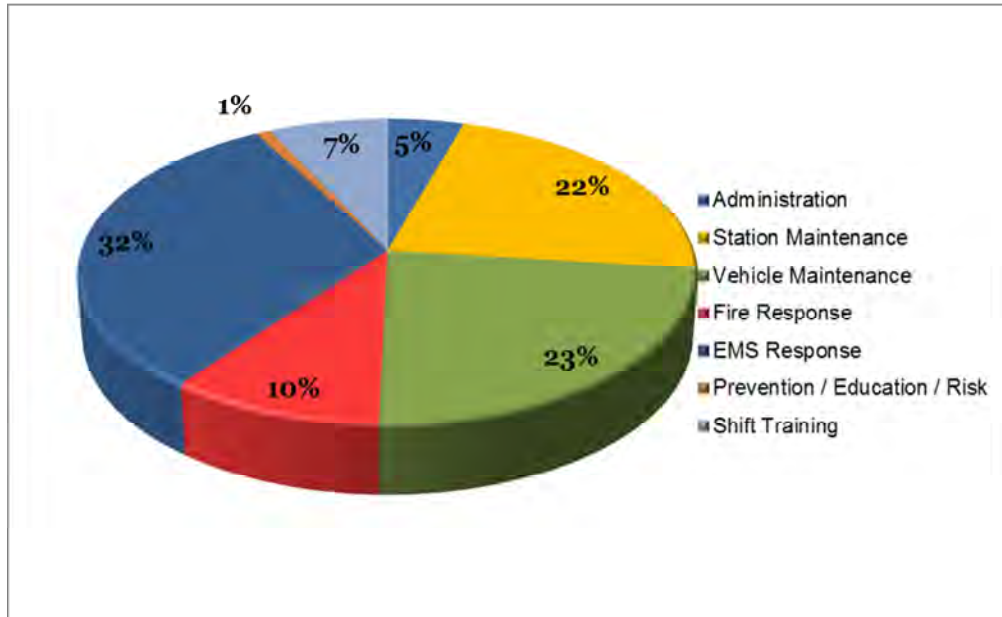


Ambulance service continues to be the highest requested service at 82%. Structure fire activity was 2% and False alarms represented 7% of all June emergent activity. There was \$68,500 dollars in fire loss in the month of June.

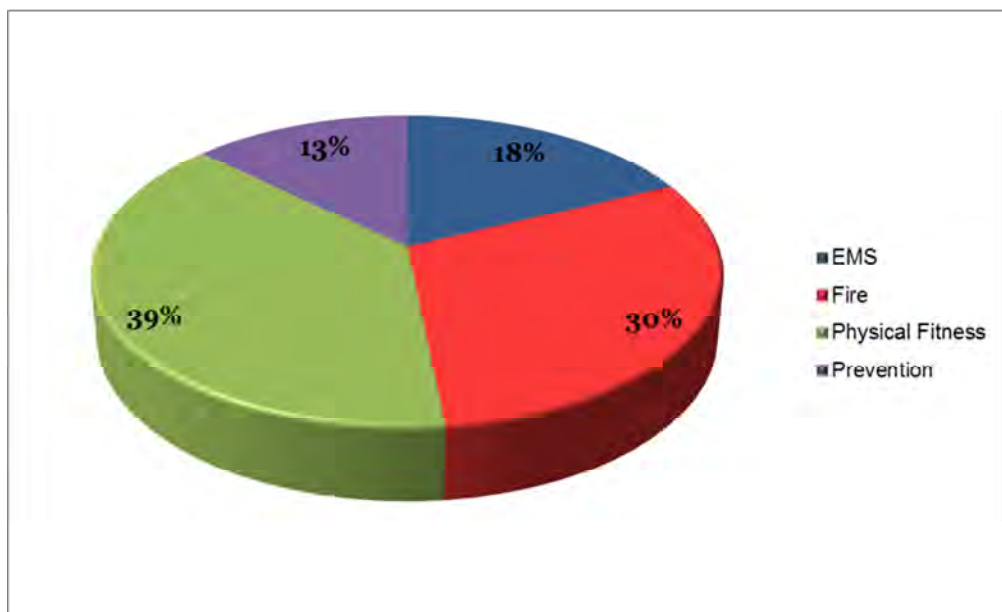


Activity



Forty-two percent of all June activity was emergency response. Station and vehicle maintenance was 23% and training was 7%.

Training Analysis

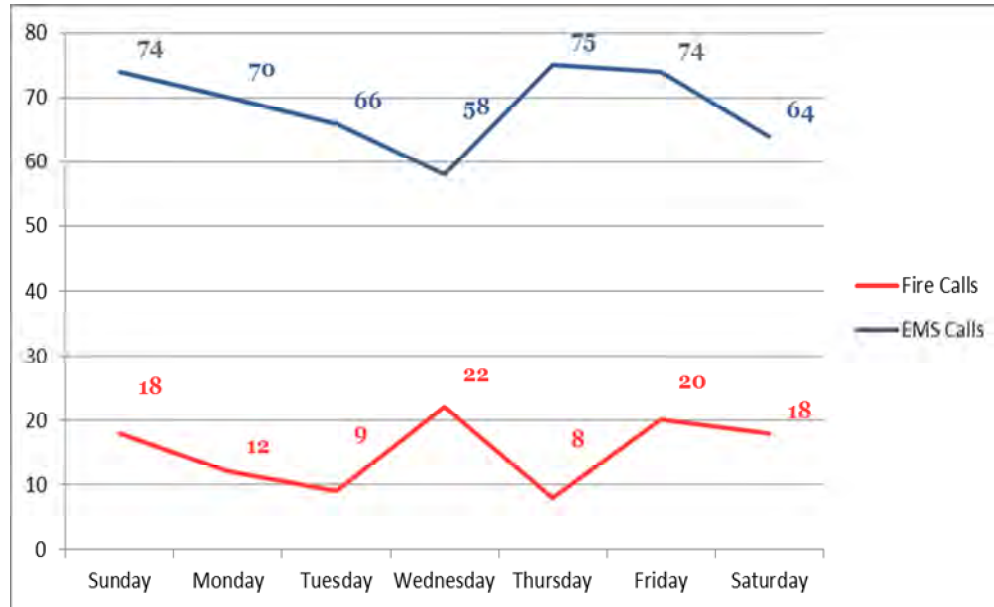


Thirty-nine percent of June training was physical fitness training. Thirty-six percent was fire training with the focus on fire ground operations. Thirteen percent focused on rescue and prevention.

- The Sandusky Fire Department used 814.073 gallons of fuel at a cost of 2,810.70 in June 2014.

Staffing

- The average daily staffing for June was 11 personnel per day.
