



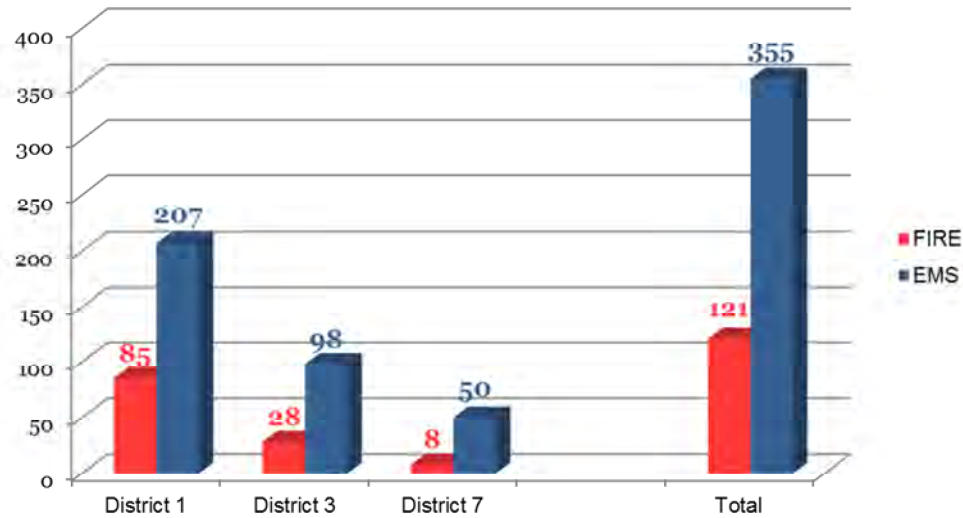

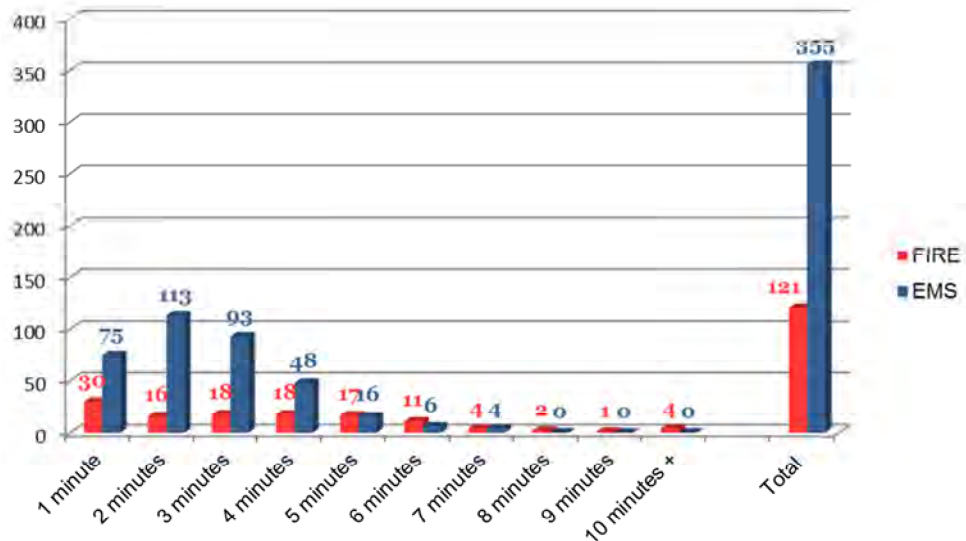


## District Statistics



There were 476 responses in October. 61% percent of all responses were in District 1. Responses in District 3 and District 7 were 27% and 12% respectively.

## Response Time

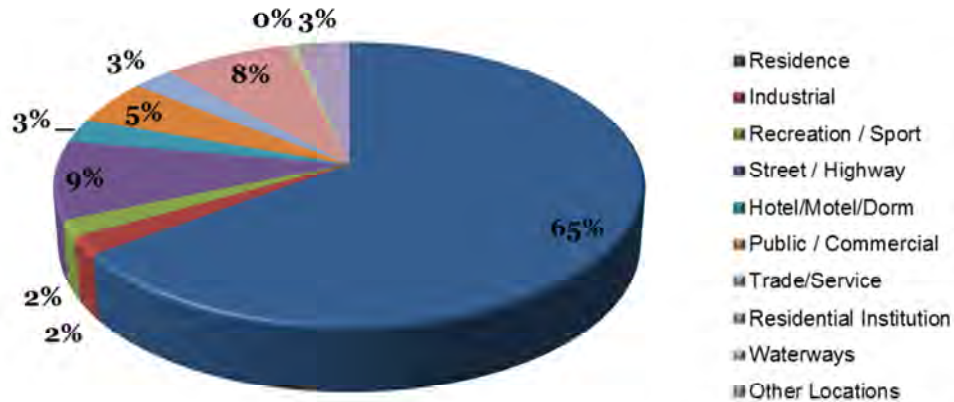


The average response time for fire emergencies was 3 minutes and 53 seconds. The average response time for EMS emergencies was 3 minutes and 01 seconds.

The Sandusky Fire Department responded to 67% of fire emergencies within four minutes and 92% of EMS emergencies within four minutes. This calculates to 86% of all emergency calls within four minutes.

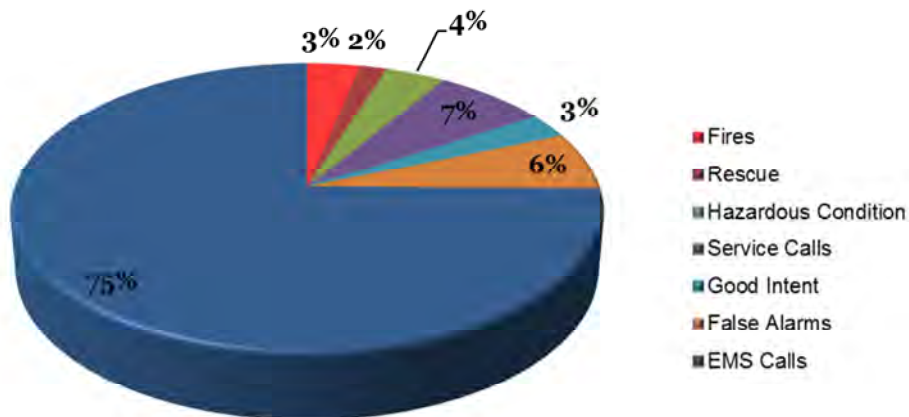


## Response by Location



In October, 76% of all emergency responses were to residential occupancies (residences, nursing homes and residential institutions). Commercial buildings, recreational occupancies and streets and highways totaled 16%.

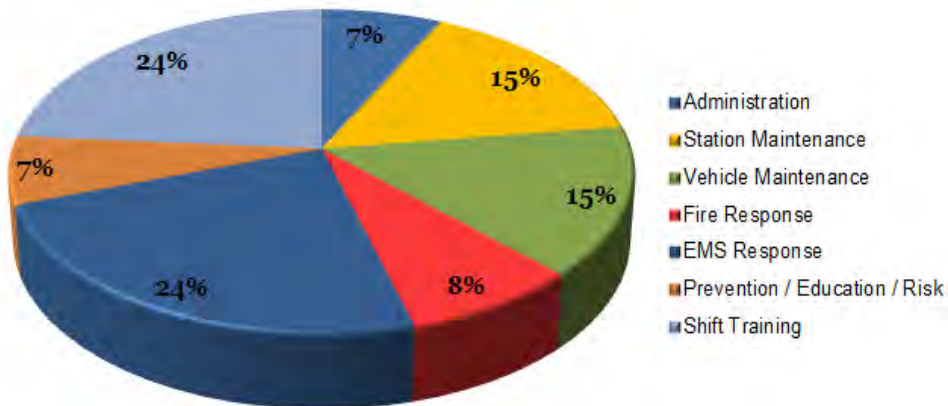
## Incident Type



Ambulance service continues to be the highest requested service at 75%. Structure fire activity was 3% of all emergent activity. False alarms represented 6% of all October emergent activity. There was \$33,250 in fire loss.

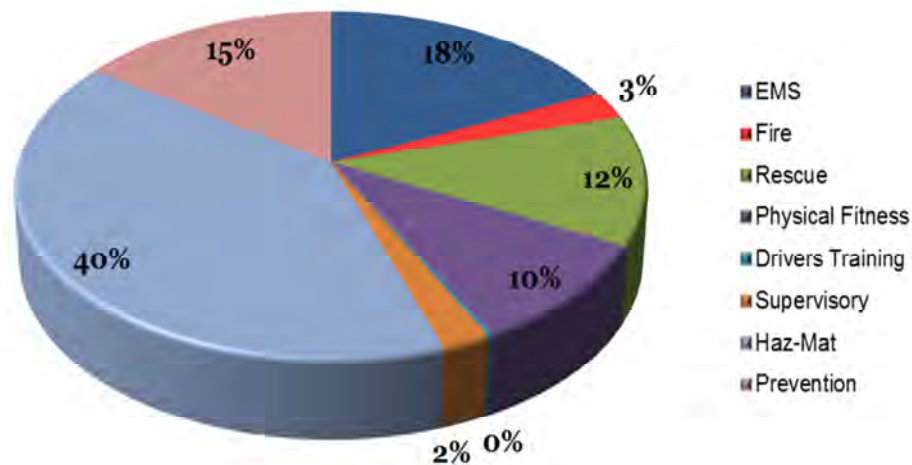


## Activity



32% percent of all October activity was emergency response. Station and vehicle maintenance was 30% and training was 24%.

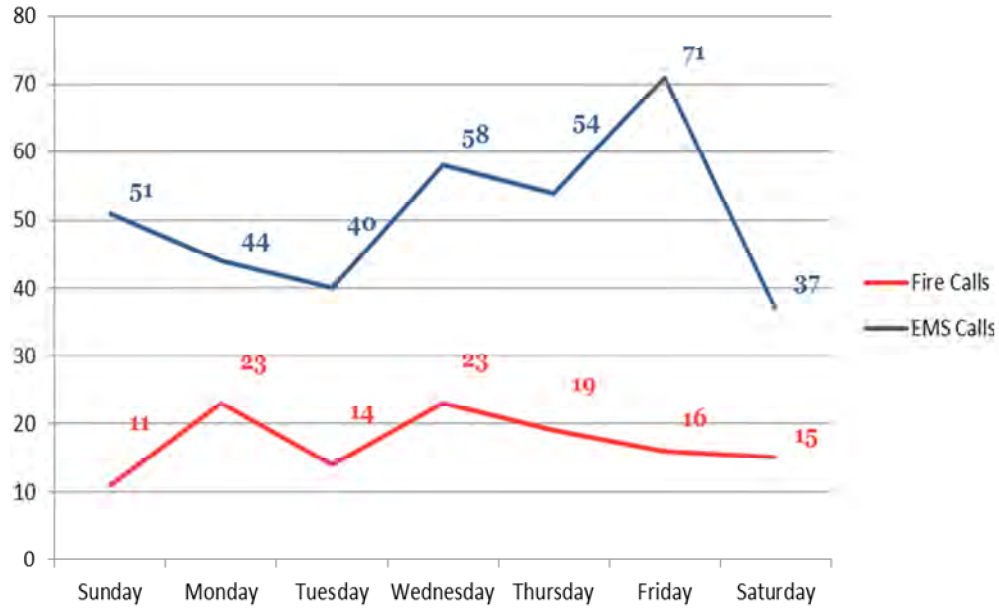
## Training Analysis



40% of October training was Hazardous Materials training. 18% of training focused on EMS and 15% percent focused on prevention.
