- Lance Warner – requests information regarding planning for downtown area. Reported that City Engineer is working on five year plan. This plan will have pieces involving downtown area.
 - Mr. Warner specifically asks if the plan provides for Shoreline Drive upgrades including the burial on power lines in the street.
 - Discussion on urban renewal designations and possible funding sources that may provide infrastructure improvements.
- Question from member on SanBay building redevelopment plan. No information at this time.
- Mike Zuilhof – requests information regarding the Chesapeake-Jackson Street park development plan. Reported that block grant money provided funds for grading and seed last year. This area will be part of the Jackson Street Pier plan
 - John Lippus expands discussion for this area as it pertains to Homeland Security's requirements for the ferry service to Canada.
- David Miller – requests information regarding plans for the northwest area of the Chesapeake as dedicated park. Staff reports that funding is available for green space improvements.
- Mike Zuilhof – requests information regarding the Pipe Creek Wildlife Area (Big Island) and launch facilities for canoes and the Sandusky Rowing Club. Staff reports that the City has been discussing and exploring options for dockage in this area.
