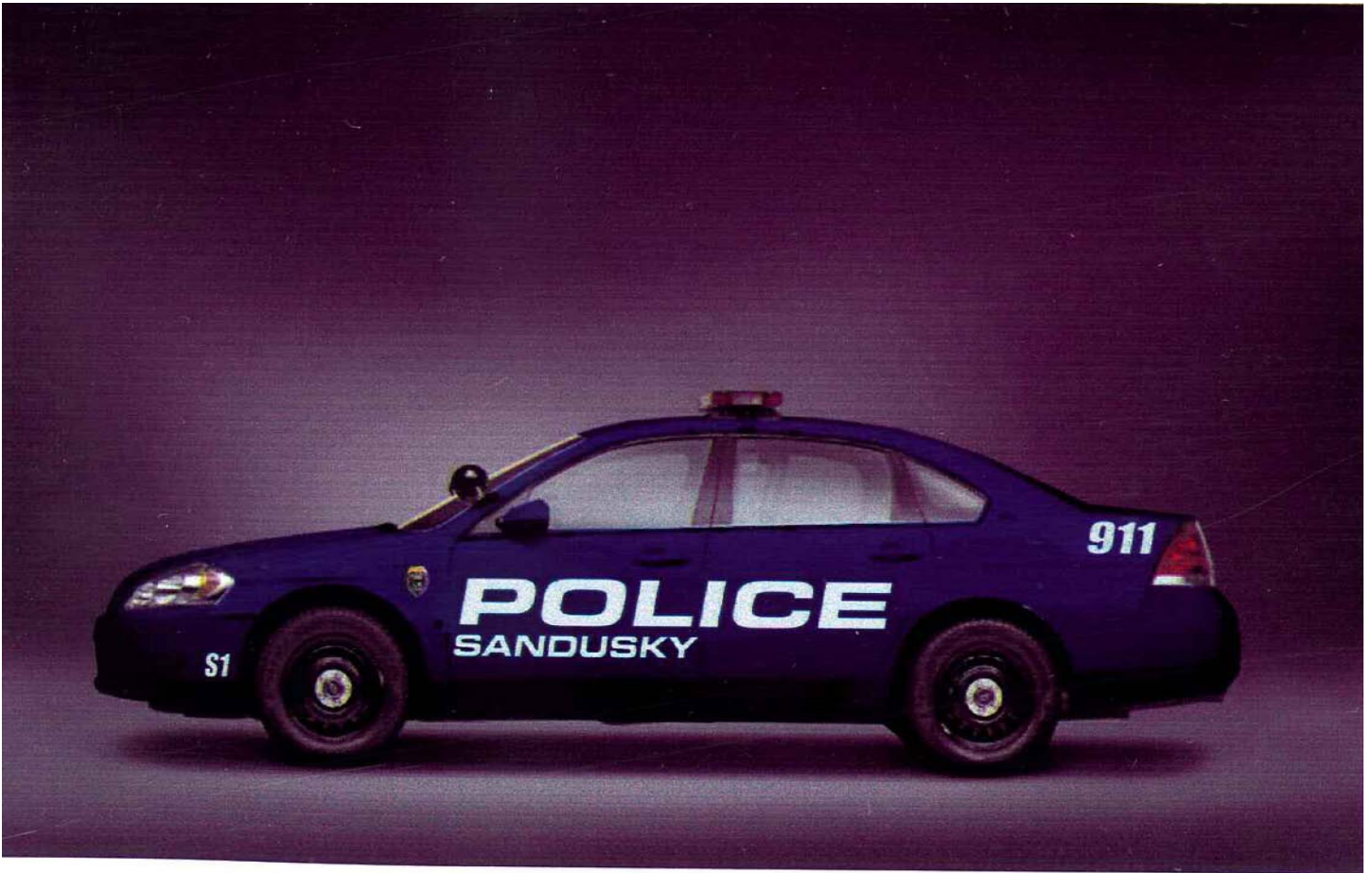


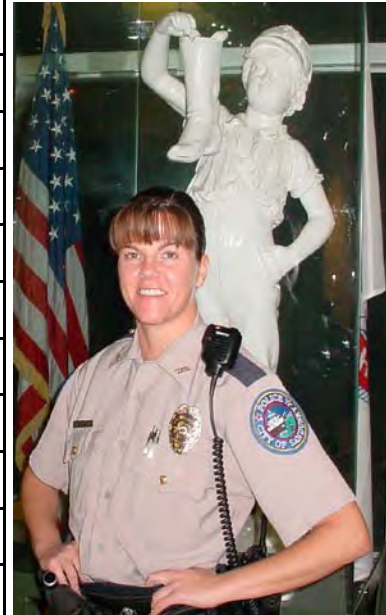

# Sandusky Police Department

## 2010 Year End Review

The Sandusky Police Department faced many challenges in 2010. As the economy continued to struggle, the city of Sandusky was forced to make some very difficult decisions. As a result of those decisions, six police officers, one dispatcher, one administrative secretary, one evidence officer, and six-reserve police officer were laid off. In addition, a number of employees retired or found other employment. The Sandusky Police Department began 2010 with 72 employees and ended the year with 51 employees.

Faced with the challenge of a reduced work force and a reduced budget, the men and women of the Sandusky Police Department worked together to overcome many obstacles as a result of the struggling economy. Many employees took on extra job assignments and the unions worked well with the administration to get through these difficult times.

Once again Sandusky was the host of Ohio Bike Week in our downtown area. This very popular event brings large crowds of people to our downtown. And once again we provided security for this very large event, which went on without any significant incidents.

A new and exciting event came to the city of Sandusky in 2010 was the Rev3 Triathlon. This event was highly successful and officers provided security, traffic control and encouragement for the participants.

Community Orientated Policing continued at our sub-station located at 2012 Fox Run Trail Apartment #10. Our officers continue to partner with W-T Realty at that location and work to make the neighborhood a safe place for our citizens to live.

The Sandusky Police Department again participated in the State of Ohio's Click it or Ticket and Drunk Driving programs. As a result of the hard work, we were awarded a 2011 Ford Crown Victoria Police Cruiser.

In September, the Sandusky Police Department welcomed Chief James Lang to the department. Chief Lang brings in a wealth of experience and professionalism. The Police Department will continue to move forward and grow under Chief Lang's leadership and direction.

As we move forward into 2011 we recognize that a police department exists for only one purpose: **To Serve The Public!**

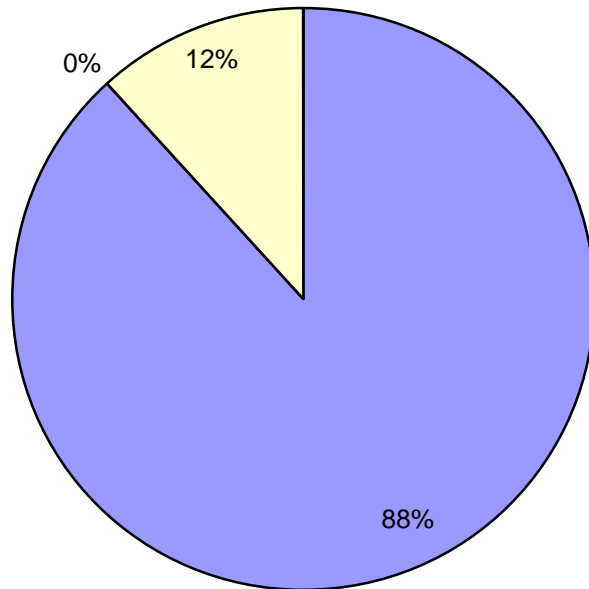

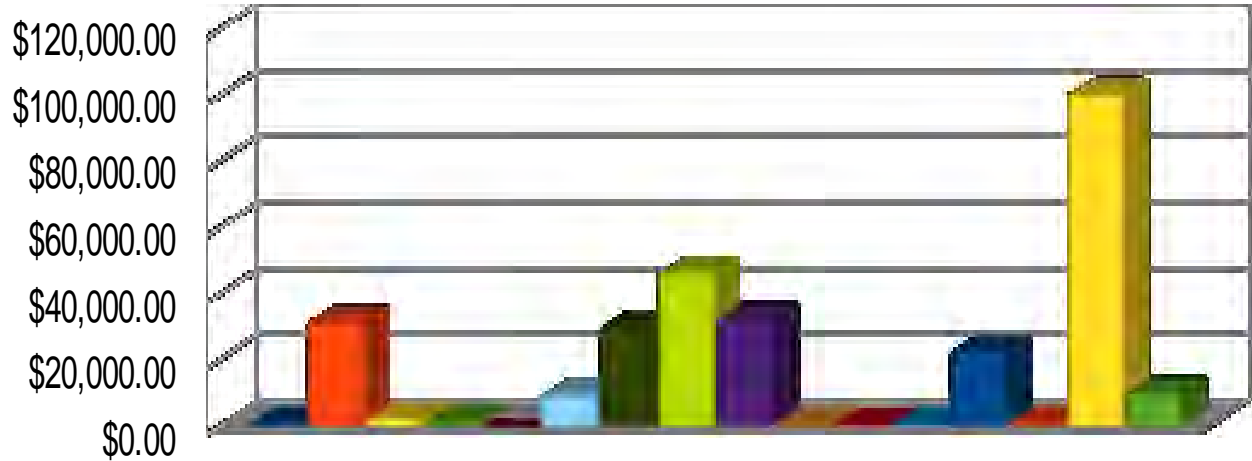

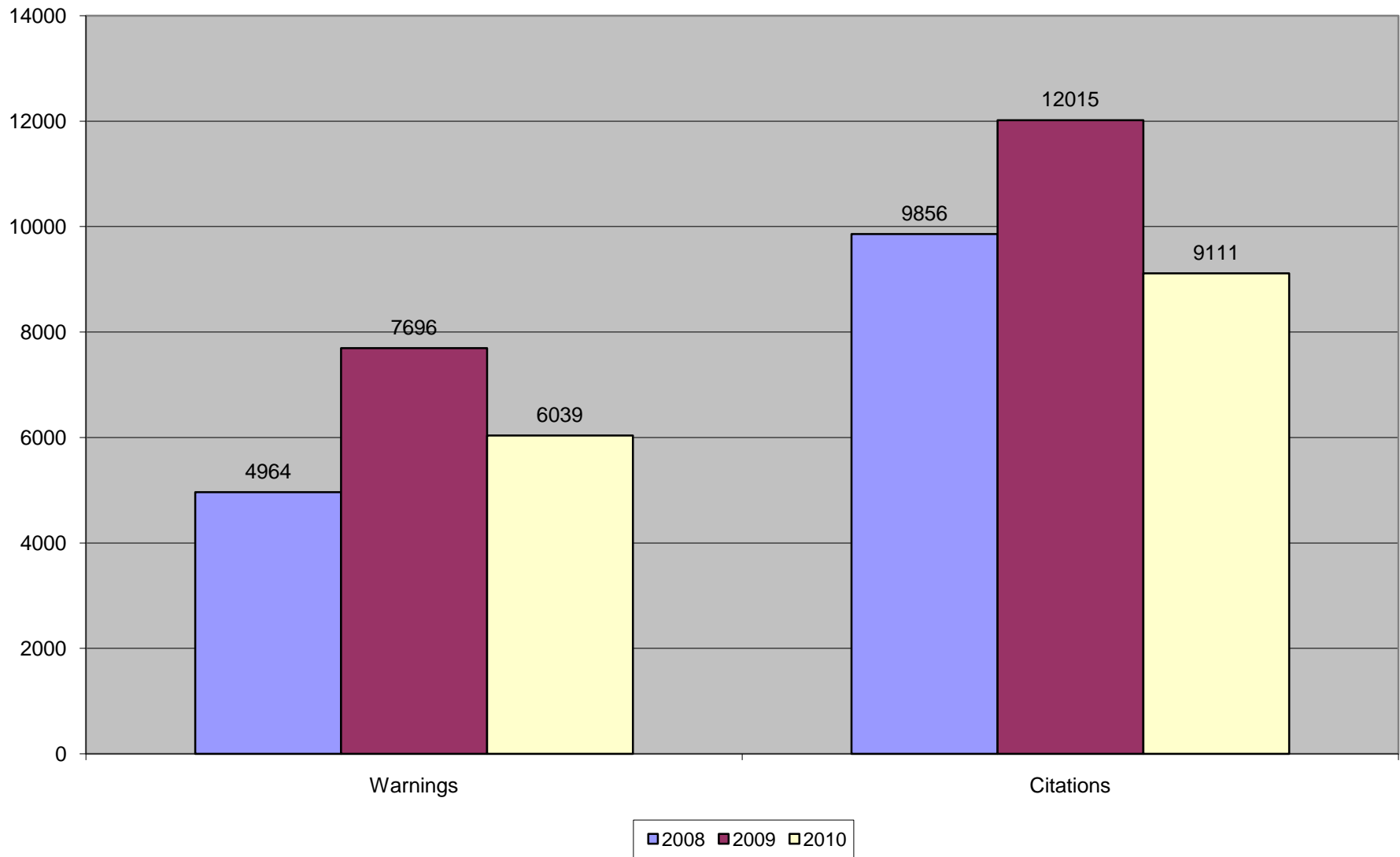

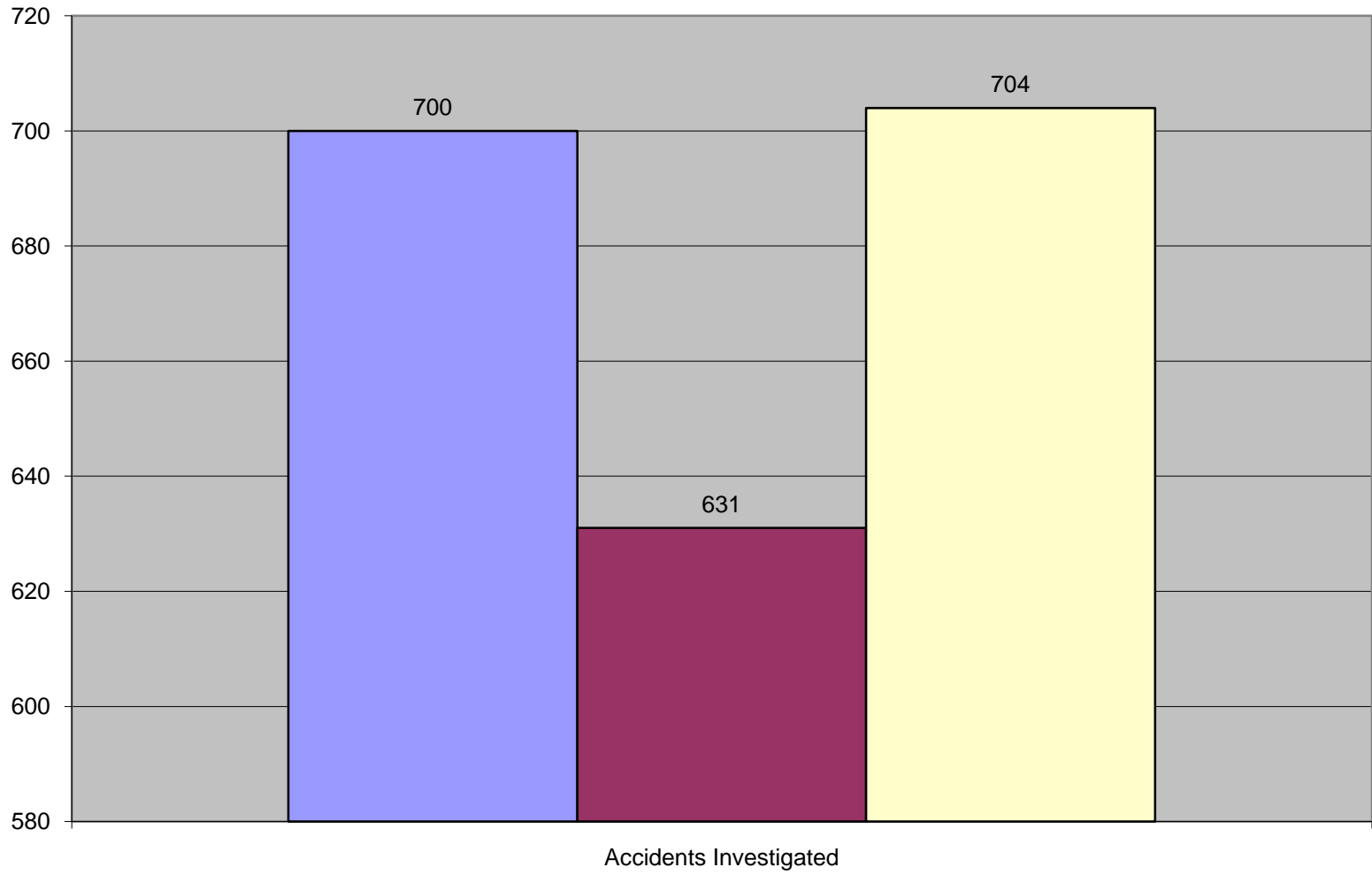
# Sandusky Police Department Traffic Enforcement With Warnings

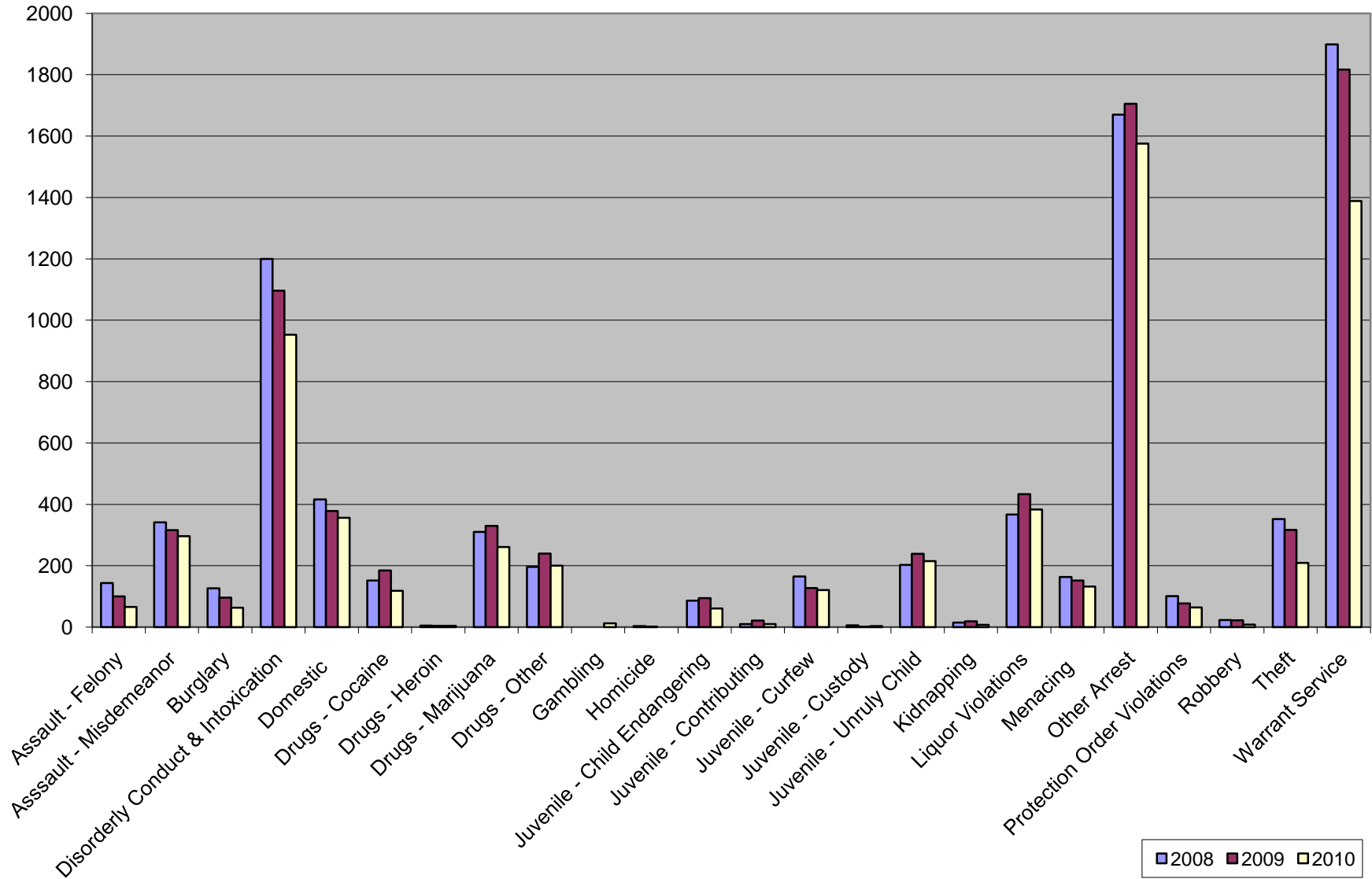
